On April 15,16 and 17, the inaugural Fleurieu Festival of One Act Plays will be held in the Old Aldinga Institute, Old Coach Road, next to the Aldinga Hotel at 8.00 pm and 2.00 pm on Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 April 2011.
