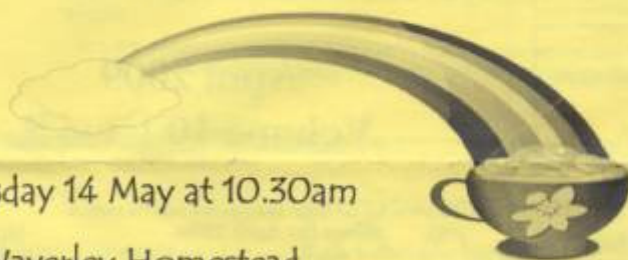

David Parle was born in Sydney in 1948 he studied Drawing, Composition and Painting at East Sydney Technical School in 1966 and 1967. In March 1970 David moved to Adelaide. During the seventies he painted vigorously in his spare time, and exhibited on several occasions with other artists and had a few one-man-shows. David spent some time living and working in Queensland and in the Northern Territory and whilst in South East Queensland he taught portrait painting at TAFE during the 1980's as well as giving private and group tuition. In 1995 he moved to McLaren Vale and has painted full time since, mainly doing commissioned portraits and other work which has been exhibited locally. His portraits and other commissions are represented in collections in all states of Australia as well as in Great Britain, Germany, France, USA and New Zealand.

"Drawing, painting and all forms of art have been my passion since as long as I can remember. My father was an exceptional watercolourist and I was very much influenced by his ability, encouragement and wisdom."

Portrait painting became his premier artistic pursuit with little time for other subject matter. He now paints and teaches art and works every day in his Tatachilla studio. He considers that the Fleurieu Peninsula and in particular the local area are a constant source of inspiration as well as being a beautiful place to live.

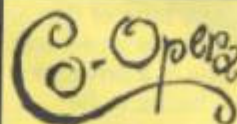
