## Liana Vargas

Teatro del Mundo's Artistic Director Liana Vargas has performed in Madrid (La Zambra) and Mexico City (Meson Triana) and in the U.K. danced at Covent Garden, the Royal Albert Hall and at Sadler's Wells. She has also performed and taught extensively within California and performed at the infamous El Cid Flamenco Tablao. 2008 marks her Silver Anniversary as a flamenco dancer and her celebrations have begun with her company's new work Duende which just finished a very successful Fringe season. Her first Art Exhibition is set for Friday the 30<sup>th</sup> of May at Waverley Homestead together with Helen Woods.



Over the past six months Liana has dedicated herself to writing her Memoir about her flamenco experiences and is currently working on having her book published (titled Duende Dancer) and in preparation for its release Liana has agreed to be a 'living book' as part of Writers' Week within the Adelaide Bank Festival of Arts. She can be borrowed from the State Library!

Meanwhile Liana continues to teach, from her cottage in Aldgate, her craft to eager students while inventing new ways in which to develop and present her art form. Preparations are currently underway for a national tour of Duende and her much anticipated first exhibition of flamenco paintings.

### Critique of 2008 Fringe Performance by PETER BURDON

THE Spanish poet and dramatist Federico Garcia Lorca is doing well out of Adelaide this season, but if the big-ticket opera Ainadamar is not quite your cup of sangria, Teatro del Mundo's Duende might be just the ticket.

A very nearly all-singing, all-dancing reflection on Lorca's celebrated essay on duende, the inspirational force that underpins the creative process, features the talents of flamenco legend Liana Vargas and Chris Shepherd, both of whom have a long history of performance on this theme.

Vargas and the other dancers are terrifically exciting, if not much helped by a commonplace bit of stage dressing.

An authentic touch came in the presence of the unaccountably amplified flamenco singer Titi de Algéiras, who very nearly sang his moustaches off: my kingdom for an acoustic set.

In short: Cuban heels and hot blood.

Helen Woods will return to Waverley Homestead for the opening of a joint exhibition with Liana Vargas on Friday the 30<sup>th</sup> of May 2008.

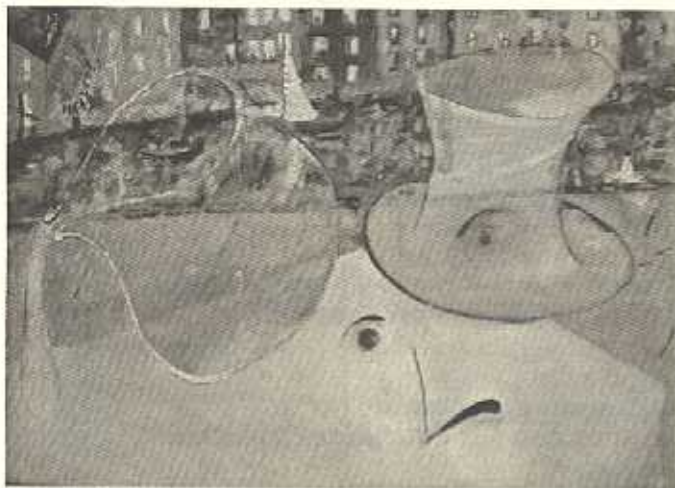

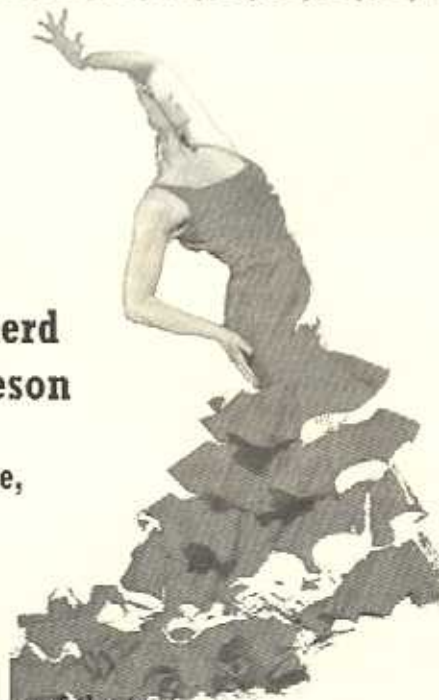
